

Chocolate Lollipop Instructions

What you will need:

- A piece of baking paper
- A lollipop stick or a straw
- A spoonful of chocolate
- Decorations
- Blu-tack

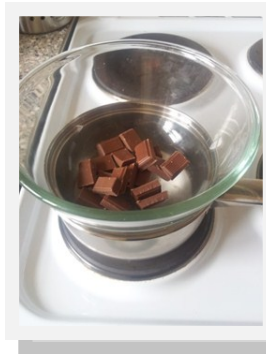


Your Teacher will need:

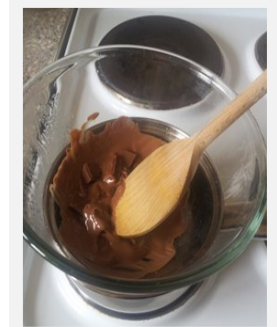
- Hob
- Saucepan
- Glass bowl
- Mixing spoon
- Chocolate

What to do:

1. Your teacher will add some chocolate a glass bowl. Next they will rest the bowl over a saucepan of water that is gently bubbling.



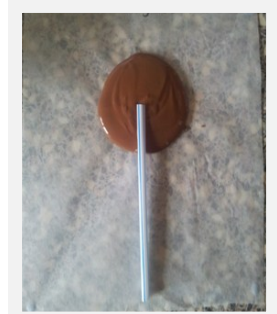
2. As the chocolate melts, your teacher will stir the chocolate with the mixing spoon. They might even ask for volunteers.



3. Stick your baking paper to the table using four, small pieces of blu-tack. Then write your name on the paper, at the top, so you know it is yours.



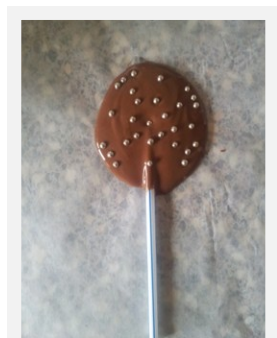
4. Your teacher will spoon some chocolate onto your baking paper. After the chocolate has run into a circle you can press your lollipop stick or straw into the chocolate in a sensible place.



5. Next you need to gently turn the lollipop stick or straw so that both sides have a coating of chocolate. Don't touch the chocolate!



6. Before the chocolate sets you can add decorations to your lollipop. Be careful not to put too many decorations on because they might not stick. Again, don't touch the chocolate.



Leave your chocolate lollipop to set completely before taking it off the baking paper.
